Gregg Skinner was named the Vice President and Program Director in March 2017.

Previously, Gregg was the General Manager, Rotors & Composite Center from November 2015 where he led the center in supporting Bell Helicopter's manufacturing production efforts in support of military and commercial customer requirements.

Gregg joined Bell Helicopter, Textron in 2012 as the Program Manager for the MQ-8C Fire Scout Program in support of The United States Navy's Urgent Need for unmanned shipboard vertical lift requirements. Bell Helicopter is a subcontractor to Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation on Naval Aviation Systems Command's contract. Upon successful EMD and initial production builds, Gregg transitioned as the Director of Repair and Overhaul Center where he led the team to successful relocation and reduced repair turnaround times by exploiting information and human capital investments.

Prior to joining Bell Helicopter in July 2012, Gregg was a Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Marine Corps. While on active duty, he flew the CH-46 and MV-22. His operational assignments were with Marine Medium Helicopter Squadron 265, Marine Tiltrotor Training Squadron 204, Marine Tiltrotor Test and Evaluation Squadron 22. His Staff billets included 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine Division, Headquarters U.S. Marine Corps, Department of Aviation. Gregg's last assignment was as the MV-22 Chief Engineer, V-22 Joint Program Office, Naval Air Systems Command.

A native from Long Island New York, Gregg earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Aeronautics & Management from Dowling College of Oakdale, N.Y. and MBA from the University of Dallas. He is certified in Systems Engineering and Program Management.
