

## **General Lance W. Lord, USAF (ret)**

**General Lord retired in April 2006 after 37 years of continuous military service. He last served as Commander, Air Force Space Command from 2002-2006 during which he was responsible for the development, acquisition and operation of Air Force space and missile weapon systems. He led more than 39,700 personnel who provided space and intercontinental ballistic missile combat capabilities to North American Defense Command and U.S. Strategic Command. Gen. Lord currently serves as a member of the Board of Aerojet Rocketdyne Holdings, Marotta Controls Corporation, Frequency Electronics Corporation, and Boneal Aerospace Corporation. Gen. Lord is the Chairman and founder of L2 Aerospace LLC since 2010. He is the 2014 recipient of the American Astronautical Society Military Astronautics Award. He is a member of the U.S. Strategic Command Senior Advisory Group, a Senior Associate of HF Global Net LLC; a Senior Associate of the Four-Star Group; and a member of the Iridium Corporation's Government Advisory Board. He is an Advisor to Skeyeon LLC, Hypergiant LLC, Chandra Space Technologies LLC, Desk Top Alert LLC, MeasuredRisk LLC, General Dynamics Mission Systems and The White Oak Group LLC. Gen Lord is an emeritus member of the Board of Advisors for the Challenger Learning Center in Colorado Springs, Colorado; Former Chairman of the Board of Advisors to the USO Colorado Springs; a Falcon Foundation Trustee; President of the Association of Air Force Missileers and an Executive Board Member of Von's Vision, Denver, Colorado.**
