Another great turnout (around 30) for the chapter that created numerous great and relevant connections. And the shooting and barbecue was fun, too!



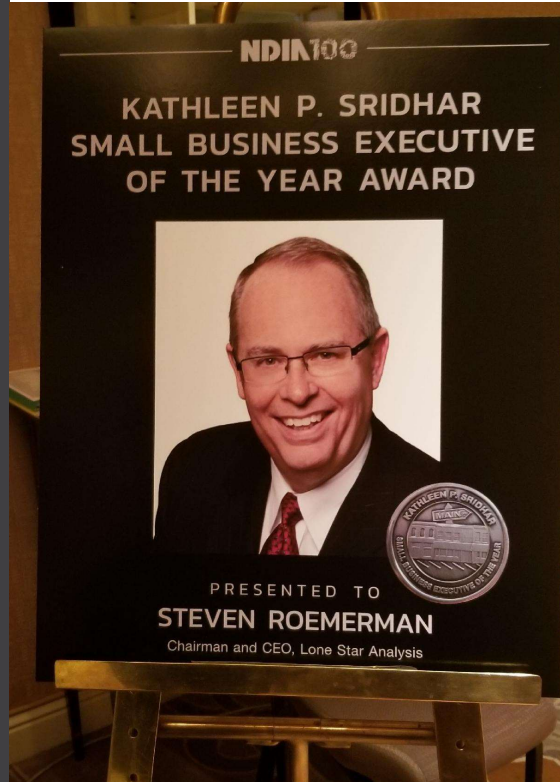
