Gary Fleegle is the President and Chief Executive Officer for National Center for Defense Manufacturing and Machining (NCDMM). In this role he is responsible for the overall mission, vision, and strategic direction of the organization to create and manage collaboration networks to transition manufacturing technology to the defense industrial base. Mr. Fleegle has been with NCDMM since 2004 and has held various positions including Executive Vice President, Chief Operating Officer, and Chief Financial Officer where he established operations and financial systems to grow the organization to a +\$50m in annual revenue.

In 2012, he was an integral part of the team that competed for and won what is now America Makes, the National Additive Manufacturing Institute, a public private partnership between government, industry, academia and other not for profits and is the first of the Manufacturing USA Institutes. Mr. Fleegle served as the founding Director of Technology for America Makes and was responsible for the development and implementation of the membership agreement, project call management process, and roadmapping efforts.

Mr. Fleegle is the current Chairman of the National Defense Industrial Association (NDIA) Manufacturing Division and is responsible for leading the Division core efforts in Technology, Supply Chain, and Workforce Education. He is also responsible for collaboration and outreach to NDIA local chapters and other NDIA Divisions.

He holds a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Finance from Clarion University of Pennsylvania, a Masters of Business Administration from Saint Francis University, and a Masters Certificate in Government Contracting from George Washington University.
